INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Cornerstone offers a variety of one-time and long-term volunteer opportunities for individuals looking to donate their time and talents.

CHILDCARE PROVIDER: Play, create art, read books, and tend to infants while their parents attend support groups. Shifts are 1.5 hours on weekday evenings and Thursdays during the day.

MAINTENANCE/GARDENING: Share your skills or trade to help maintain the emergency shelter and transitional housing units. Assist with landscaping needs to keep our grounds welcoming for clients. No experience is required.

VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT: Support the volunteer department by assisting with database entry, organizing volunteer groups, clerical support and participating in special events.

EVENT SUPPORT: Support our development department by assisting at special events geared toward raising awareness and support for Cornerstone's programs. Tasks may include pre-event support, room set up, staffing information tables, or photographing the event. Most events are during the evening or on weekends.

SHELTER ADVOCATE: Answer calls to our 24-Hour helpline and provide assistance and support to the women and families in our shelter.
